



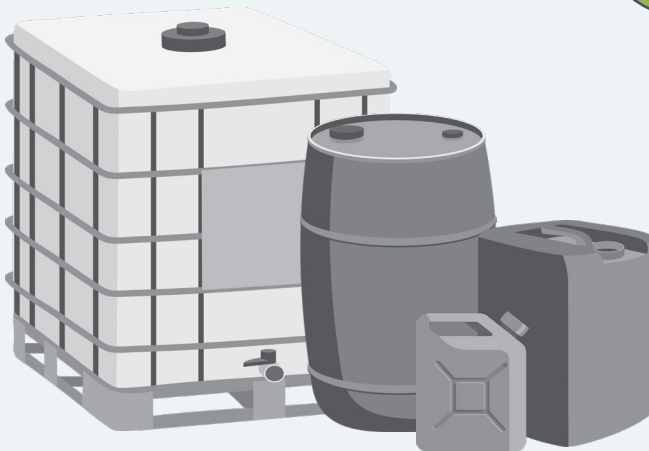

Agrecovery's Product Stewardship Scheme provides New Zealand farmers and growers with free recovery and recycling of empty plastic agrichemical containers, drums and IBCs.



AGRICHEMICAL CONTAINERS

0 - 60 LITRES WITH LID REMOVED

Step 1: Prepare

Containers must be triple rinsed and completely drained of any chemical residue and dirt inside and out. Only containers from one of our 100+ participating brand owners are free to recycle - leave labels on for identification. Scan the QR code on the back to view full acceptance criteria and a list of participating brands.

Step 2: Drop-off at your local collection site

Our website lists over 160 permanent collection sites located across New Zealand. We also collect on-property for large volumes (500+ containers).

Step 3: Inspection and Acceptance

All containers are inspected before being accepted and a recycling record can be downloaded from our website for auditing purposes.

DRUMS AND IBCS

61 - 1000 LITRES WITH BUNG REMOVED

Step 1: Prepare

Drums must be triple rinsed and completely drained of any chemical residue and dirt inside and out (puncturing drums can help with draining rinse water). Scan the QR code on the back to view full acceptance criteria and a list of participating brands.

Step 2: Book collection on our website

A minimum of four large drums or one IBC is required for on-property collection. Only drums from our 50+ participating brand owners are free to recycle. Please leave labels on for identification. Other brands are subject to fees payable at time of booking.

Step 3: Collection

Drums will be collected on a quarterly basis. We will contact you ahead of collection.

WHAT HAPPENS TO THE PLASTIC WE RECOVER?



100% of this type of plastic is reused right here in New Zealand. It is taken to local recyclers and processed into safe end uses like underground utility cable cover as part of the circular economy.

- Remove paperwork at collection sites with a member key tag
