



PREP YOUR PLASTIC!

HOW TO PREPARE YOUR SMALL BAGS FOR FREE RECYCLING

Scan the QR codes to order your free liners and view a full list of collection site locations and participating brands for each plastic bag type. There is a green liner for LDPE bags and a purple liner for Woven PP bags. Bags should be placed in their corresponding liner and **MUST NOT** be mixed. Please ensure you follow the steps below to ensure your bags can be accepted for recycling.

ORDER A LINER AND CODED ZIP TIE THROUGH AGRECOVERY



Zip ties have unique codes so the collection site can record your recycling in your Agrecovery account.

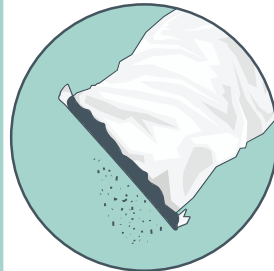
ENSURE THE TOPS OF YOUR EMPTY BAGS HAVE BEEN FULLY OPENED



Fully remove the string or cut along the top of the bag to easily remove any excess residue.

TURN BAGS UPSIDE DOWN AND GIVE THEM A GOOD SHAKE



Ensure the bag is clean and free of residue, dirt and contamination - both inside and out.

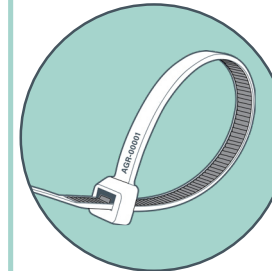
PUT THE CLEAN, EMPTY BAGS IN THE AGRECOVERY LINER SUPPLIED



Place empty bags in their correct corresponding liner. Full liners should fit between 60-100 bags.

WHEN FULL, SEAL THE LINER WITH THE CODED ZIP TIE SUPPLIED



Store full liners in a dry, shaded location. Liners should be dropped-off as soon as possible.

DROP YOUR FULL LINERS OFF AT YOUR NEAREST COLLECTION SITE



All bags and liners will be inspected by site staff to ensure acceptance criteria has been met.
